VANDALISM

1. Staff, students and members of the general public shall be encouraged to report any vandalism to school authorities or law enforcement officials.
2. Following an investigation to determine the person responsible for vandalism or damage to any CCS property, the Superintendent may recommend action to the School Board to recover from the parent(s) of the offender, living with such parent(s), up to \$2500 for damages.
3. A student who damages or destroys public property will be subject to whatever disciplinary action is deemed necessary and advisable by the school principal. The process for determining any disciplinary action will not be same as a process to recover damages through the court system.
