ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

1. In an effort to pursue environmental management and sustainability, the Superintendent and staff shall attempt to protect the health of staff and students and the environment by:
 - A. compliance with regulatory and voluntary requirements (including but not limited to chemical management, hazardous and solid waste management, indoor air quality, and sustainable building practices),
 - B. institution of pollution prevention initiatives where practicable and feasible;
 - C. a commitment to continually improving environmental management and performance; and designation of resources, roles, and responsibilities.
2. The Assistant Superintendent for Administration, in collaboration with other school division employees, and members of the City of Charlottesville staff shall develop a formal Environmental Management System (EMS).
3. The plan will be examined to ensure that it becomes a standard of operation.
4. Review of operations and related environmental aspects and impacts, training, communication, documentation, and establishment of improvement objectives and targets will be key elements of the Division's Environmental Management Program.
5. The environmental management policy and procedures to carry out the plan shall be communicated to all employees of Charlottesville City Schools, and shall be made available to the public upon request. The plan is located in the Administrative Services Handbook.

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
