FACILITIES PLANNING

The Charlottesville City School Board is responsible for the regular operation and orderly development of all school facilities. The Board will concern itself with both short and long-range planning.

The Superintendent shall present to the School Board annually, or as necessary to coordinate with the planning process of the appropriating body, a Capital Improvement Program which will include recommendations and alterations regarding timing, location, costs and savings associated with:

1. New building requirements
2. Restoration and renewal of existing school facilities

The Superintendent may make recommendations for new buildings and renovations after there has been input concerning facilities utilization, development and closure from a broad-based committee representing the staff and community.

Recommendations will be supported by data that support the feasibility and need for construction and/or renovation.
