### ACCOMMODATIONS FOR THE DISABLED

1. Plans for new buildings and renovations or alterations of existing buildings shall offer a design and accommodations to make the newly constructed buildings and renovated or altered areas accessible to persons with disabilities.
2. Construction plans for new buildings and renovations or alterations to existing buildings must meet accessibility standards as specified in either the Uniform Federal Accessibility Standards (Appendix to 41 C.F.R. Part 101-119.6) or the Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines for Buildings and Facilities (Appendix A to 28 C.F.R. Part 36).
3. Copies of plans for accommodations made to any CCS buildings for persons with disabilities will be maintained by the City of Charlottesville Facilities Department.
