NAMING OF FACILITIES AND GROUNDS

The Charlottesville City School Board may recognize truly exceptional individual contributions by naming facilities, rooms, or grounds or parts thereof after such individuals.

To be nominated or considered for a naming honor, the individual must be retired, or no longer be working with Charlottesville City Schools or have formally notified the division that he or she is leaving the school system within one year.

The School Board shall also have the responsibility to authorize naming rights for portions of school facilities in order to provide recognition for private individuals or corporate entities that make a significant financial contribution to benefit Charlottesville City Schools.

Accompanying regulations will outline the procedures for any person or group to recommend a name for any Charlottesville City School facility or any portion of a facility. The regulations will also specify any criteria regarding renaming of facilities if situations warrant a change or after a specified time period.
