STAFF WEAPONS IN SCHOOLS

The Charlottesville City School Board is committed to maintaining a safe and secure working and learning environment.

- 1. Staff are prohibited from carrying, bringing, using or possessing any weapon, as defined in <u>JFCD</u>, in any school building, on school grounds, in any school vehicle or at any school-sponsored activity without the authorization of the school or the school division.
- 2. If an employee is suspected of violating the actions in Item 1, the Superintendent or designee shall conduct an investigation. The Superintendent may place the employee on administrative leave during the investigation.
- 3. If the investigation is founded, the Superintendent and School Board will take appropriate personnel action up to and including dismissal of any employee found in violation of this provision.
- 4. All incidents involving illegal carrying of a firearm shall be reported to law enforcement in accordance with state law.
- 5. This prohibition does not include persons who are otherwise allowed by law to have a weapon on school property including a school resource officer.
