TEACHING ABOUT DRUGS, ALCOHOL, AND TOBACCO

1. Each student shall receive instruction in drug education in accordance with the guidelines set forth by the Virginia Board of Education and shall receive first aid instruction for drug abuse at the appropriate levels.
2. Each student shall receive instruction concerning the public safety hazards and dangers of alcohol abuse, underage drinking, and driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
3. The instruction for these areas shall be delivered as a part of health/physical education curriculum.
4. The curriculum shall be reviewed annually by the Coordinator for Health and Physical Education.
5. A committee will be formed for any curriculum revisions.
6. Once revisions are prepared, the revisions will be presented to the Associate Superintendent for Instruction for review.
7. Revisions will then be provided to the Superintendent for approval.
8. The Superintendent or designee shall inform the School Board regarding minor changes in the curriculum.
9. If significant revisions in curriculum or course changes are proposed, the Superintendent shall present the changes to the Board for approval.
