ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL PROGRAMS

- 1. Alternative programs may be established by the Charlottesville City School Board within existing schools or at separate sites that are within the jurisdiction of the Charlottesville City Schools.
- 2. No person of school age meeting the residency requirements of Section 22.1-3 may be charged tuition for enrollment in an alternative program offered as a regional or division-wide initiative by the School Board.
- 3. Specific admission criteria for each alternative education program shall be developed by CCS administrators and will be made available to students who may qualify.
- 4. When possible, the alternative education program shall closely follow the curriculum and procedures for other CCS schools to facilitate transitions back to a school.
- 5. Students who attend any alternative education program shall follow all procedures and expectations of the school program.
- 6. Proposals for alternative programs will be created by the Superintendent, designee or group appointed by the Superintendent.
- 7. The proposal must include all elements described in Policy IGBH.
