ADMISSION OF HOMELESS CHILDREN

1. The principal at each school shall follow all proscribed procedures for the enrollment and educational program for all children experiencing homelessness and eligible for McKinney Vento services.
2. All procedures required for the admission of children experiencing homelessness are located in the Department of Special Education and Student Services Handbook.
3. A copy of the manual is located in each school office and at the Office of Special Education and Student Services.
4. Specific issues addressed in the procedures and in Policy JECA include definition of homeless, registration process, missing materials for enrollment, documentation of homelessness, attendance at the school of origin, appeals for enrollment decisions, transportation for school of origin and comparable services.
