## STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

- 1. Students who become serious disciplinary problems on the bus will be reported to the principal by the driver and may have their riding privileges suspended.
- 2. The principal or other administrator shall review the discipline referral to determine the appropriate consequence for the action.
- 3. In cases where riding privileges are suspended, the parents of the student shall be notified in writing of the length of suspension and the reason for the suspension.
- 4. The parents shall be responsible for the child's transportation to and from school.
