STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

1. Students who become serious disciplinary problems on the bus will be reported to the principal by the driver and may have their riding privileges suspended.
2. The principal or other administrator shall review the discipline referral to determine the appropriate consequence for the action.
3. In cases where riding privileges are suspended, the parents of the student shall be notified in writing of the length of suspension and the reason for the suspension.
4. The parents shall be responsible for the child's transportation to and from school.
