TOBACCO-FREE SCHOOL FOR STUDENTS

Smoking, chewing or any other use of any tobacco products by students shall be prohibited on school property.

1. The definitions for [Policy JFCH](#) and this regulation are found in the policy.
2. Policy JFCH shall be published in student handbooks, posted on bulletin boards, summarized in the [Code of Student Conduct](#) and announced in meetings.
3. Students found to be in violation of this policy shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action.
4. The Superintendent may issue additional regulations designating smoking areas on school grounds outside buildings.
5. Each principal shall post signage stating “No Smoking” or containing the international “No Smoking” symbol consisting of a pictorial representation of a burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle with a bar across it clearly and conspicuously in every school cafeteria and other dining facility n the school.
