NOTIFICATION REGARDING PROSECUTION OF JUVENILES AS ADULTS

1. The Assistant Superintendent for Administrative Services will annually include information from the Office of the Attorney General regarding laws governing the prosecution of juveniles as adults for the commission of certain crimes in the Code of Student Conduct.
 2. Additionally, the Code of Student Conduct will also include the following information for students:
 - A. all adult convictions (i.e. from age 18 and up or juvenile charges treated as adult charges) stay on a person's record for the rest of his/her life under Virginia law, and
 - B. convictions on a criminal record can have serious negative impacts on their ability to get jobs and to generally pursue their goals in life.
