### STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Charlottesville City Schools shall comply with the Code of Virginia requirements in matters relating to health, physical examinations, and inoculations.
2. For any issues with questions regarding the State Department of Health Regulations, interpretation shall be sought from the Charlottesville City Department of Health (See Policies [JHCA](#) and [JHCB](#) and their accompanying [regulations](#)).
3. The CCS School Board may hire school nurses, physicians, physical therapists, occupational therapists, and speech therapists meeting the standards determined by the Board of Education.

#### Contagious Disease

1. Students shall be excluded from school when suffering from contagious disease. (See [Policy JHCC](#))
2. Principals shall instruct teachers to provide assignments for students as appropriate and all students shall have the opportunity to make up work without penalty.

#### Treatment of Medical Emergencies

1. No treatment of injuries, except first aid, will be given in the schools. Exceptions are made to this regulation only in cases of medical necessity. (See [policy JHCD](#))
2. Each school shall have a Medical Management Team who is trained in first aid.
3. A listing of the team members shall be available in each school office and clinic in the event, the team is needed for an emergency situation.
4. Annual training shall be provided for all Medical Management Team members in the area of first aid, medication administration, treatment for diabetic issues, and for specific medical concerns of any students enrolled in the building.

#### Rights of Students

1. The religious beliefs and constitutional rights of students shall be respected within constraints of legal requirements for health instruction, examination, and treatment.
2. Parents shall be contacted when any medical or first aid treatment is provided and if the situation allows, the parent shall be consulted about picking up the student and seeking personal medical care prior to any care by school personnel.
