COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

- A. The Superintendent shall assure that all CCS staff act in compliance with applicable law to exclude from school attendance or work in the school setting any person who has a communicable disease.
- B. Both the decision to remove the student and the decision to readmit the student to school shall be made by the Superintendent based upon consultation with the local health department, the student's physician, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, and/or other medical authorities. (See [policy JHCCA](#)).
- C. The identity of a student who has a communicable disease will be kept confidential and will be revealed only in accordance with state law.
- D. An alternative educational program will be made available to any student whose removal pursuant to this regulation is expected to result in a prolonged absence from school or where otherwise required by law. The type of program offered will be based on the specific needs and condition of the student.
