COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

The Superintendent, subject to the approval of the Board, may provide for or permit the use of school buildings and grounds out of school hours. School facilities also may be used as voting places in any primary, regular, or special election.

The Board may permit use of school property under its control when such use will not impair the efficiency of the school.

The requirements of the regular school program shall receive first consideration in the use of school facilities. School related organizations, such as the Parent-Teacher Organization, shall have priority over non-school related organizations and approved child and youth groups over adult groups.

Non-school related groups and organizations may be permitted to use school facilities at the discretion of the principal, subject to the approval by the Superintendent or designee.
