24-Hour Teen Crisis Hotline

Call anytime 24-7, no problem is too small. We can offer a friendly ear, over-the-phone crisis counseling, arrange for in-person counseling, link to emergency shelter, or refer to community programs to meet specific needs.

Counseling

The Teen Counseling Program provides free crisis and ongoing counseling to teens as young as 12 who are in need of short term, crisis based services. Counseling can take place over the phone, in home, in school, or at our office and can work with the teen individually or with the family as a whole.

Emergency Shelter

Emergency shelter is provided to teens, 12-17 years old, who need to be out of the home to prevent more serious consequences of family conflict and who are eligible based on our grant funding. Call to find out if you qualify! During the shelter stay families use TCP counseling to resolve the conflict and bring the teen back home, when possible. Otherwise, we will help to find a safe and agreeable alternative.
