- **Storage closets** have been repurposed as **classrooms or workrooms.**
- Elementary music teachers use **stages as classrooms.** Most are **undersized** for this use.
- **Hallways** used for **students working with hourly intervention staff**, without appropriate furnishings or visual/acoustic separation.
- Specialists and rotating teachers have their **desks in others' classrooms.** Must perform **planning & grading while unrelated instruction occurs in classroom.**
- Elementary **Spanish teachers rotate** among classrooms
- **Counselors** are located in shared office space, with **no private meeting space.**

GOOD NEWS:

CCS's existing schools have good bones and are well-maintained.

CHALLENGES:

CCS schools are taxed by growing enrollment and expanding programming such as STEM offerings.

OPPORTUNITIES:

Expanding CCS facilities and reconfiguring (for pre-K and grades 5-6) can meet student needs, support enrollment growth, and complement the district's modernization efforts.
