

CHS SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

GENERAL INFORMATION

Dates of Operation

- **Summer School Dates: June 17 - July 26**
- Closed July 4 and 5 in observance of Independence Day
- All work **must** be completed by July 26. Failure to complete a course by July 26 will result in a grade of **No Credit**.
- Should a course be completed before July 26, no further attendance at summer school will be required or permitted, except during End-of-Course examination.

Non-Virtual PE Session Dates:

- PE Session 1 - June 17 - July 3
- PE Session 2 - July 8 - July 26

Exam Dates:

- End of Course Exams - July 26
- SOLs - July 10, 17, and 23-26

RULES & REGULATIONS (Non-Virtual Courses)

Time of Operation - 7:45am to 1:15pm with short breaks included

Transportation - Limited bus transportation will be provided.

Meals - Breakfast and lunch will be available in the cafeteria at no cost.

Attendance:

- **Regular daily attendance is mandatory for all courses.**
- More than 2 unexcused absences will result in removal from a 1.0 credit course. Absences will only be counted as excused with a doctor or court note.
- More than 1 unexcused absences will result in removal from a 0.5 credit course. Absences will only be counted as excused with a doctor or court note.
- Students arriving more than 30 minutes late will be marked absent for the day. Three tardies will result in one absence.
- Upon completion of coursework, student attendance at summer school is neither required nor permitted.

Cell Phones & Personal Electronics:

- Cell phones should be off and away during summer school hours.
- Students who are not able to meet this request will be asked to leave their devices in the summer school office at the beginning of each instructional day. This can also result in further disciplinary action.

Student Discipline:

- **Attending summer school is a privilege.**
- CHS will provide a safe and equitable learning environment. Student discipline is everyone's responsibility. There are only two sanctions for any inappropriate student behavior in Summer School:
 - Immediate one-day suspension - 1st offense (does not count against attendance)
 - Immediate removal from summer school program - 2nd offense (no tuition refund)

End of Course SOL Exams:

- Students are required to complete the End of Course examination if enrolled in a course with an End of Course exam.

Physical Education:

- **Students can miss no more than 1 day of a PE session to receive credit for PE.**
- Lockers rooms will not be available for use. Students are responsible for all personal property including electronic devices, jewelry, wallets/purses, etc. The school and district are not responsible for loss or theft of these items. The school will not provide storage for personal property. The school strongly suggests that these items not be brought to summer school.
- Students are expected to arrive at school on time, dressed out, and ready to participate.
- Our summer school program **does not provide alternate PE curriculum** for students with injuries or illness that prevent them from completing course work. **If a student is unable to complete the PE curriculum due to injury or illness, they will be removed from the course and are encouraged to take it during the school year when they are well.**
